Expert knowledge and individualised support

Focus on ability and the individual needs of disabled and disadvantaged job seekers

- A wide range of services to prepare jobseekers for work including;
 - Pre-employment support & development
 - Vocational skills programmes and confidence building
 - Job specific training developed in partnership with employers
 - Interview techniques & CV writing
 - Structured personal development
 - Work trials and Placements
- Post employment support to help people stay in employment

What do they provide:



Work Trials, Placements and Working Interviews:

Useful:

- To try before you start employment
- For candidates who have not worked in the industry they are applying for OR have not worked for a long time OR have never worked
- For getting recent work experience on CV and a reference

Length of time (usually):

- 15 hours per week for 4 weeks for placements
- 1 week for work trials
- 1 shift/ day for working interview

What do they provide:



In Work Support

This is a free service provided to the candidate when employment is found. It is there to help the candidate:

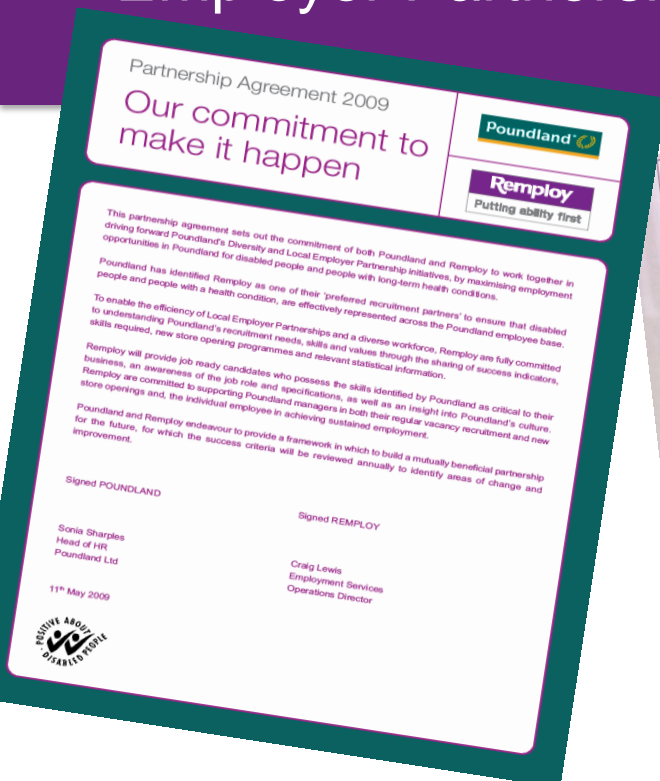
- Settle in to their new job
- Make any reasonable adjustments (if applicable)
- Job Coach where necessary
- Support with progression opportunities
- Support to ensure sustainment of employment
- Available for 5 years after employment is found

Candidates can chose between face to face contact or telephone support however their Remploy Advisor will advise on the most suitable method dependant on the individual.
