
## **Applications**



## Applications in everyday and work contexts

This diagram shows some applications in everyday and work contexts for measurement of length, weight and capacity.

The purpose of this diagram is to show situations in which these topics are particularly important. It can be thought of as a signpost for "where does it happen?"

The information is presented in a non-linear format to encourage a more creative use of the curriculum. Not all examples given needs to be followed and any one starting point is as good as another. This diagram could be used to stimulate a discussion amongst learners about where they may have come across the topic. You could also gather examples of each application, as they are relevant to learners and their programmes of learning, in order to demonstrate authentic uses. Learners could be involved in this task, bringing material from home or work. This will encourage learners to understand the relevance of understanding and being able to represent data.
