## Making a Flower Arrangement Integrated Pre-entry Curriculum Framework activity to support learning

### Recalling prior knowledge

A discussion centred on the task, which includes a period of recall using images and written representation of element criteria, that focuses on the different stages of putting together an arrangement.

## **Collecting materials for the task**

Materials are gathered and placed ready for use e.g. scissors, tape, plant material and an oasis dish. The oasis is soaked and taped into dish

Including key issues such as:

- Why is it necessary to stick the oasis in with tape?
- Why do we place foliage in first?
- Why do we spray the arrangement with water on completion?
- Why do we use a variety of flowers and foliage?



#### Making a flower arrangement

Students (with varying degrees of support) will be asked to demonstrate their skills in building up a small table decoration from scratch.

- 1. Plant material is prepared and ready for use
- 2. Foliage is placed in oasis keeping to shape
- 3. Flowers are cut and added to arrangement as instructed
- 4. Complete arrangement is checked for gaps
- 5. Completed arrangement is misted with fine water spray
