## Progress check: Entry 2 literacy

## Understand the main events of chronological and instructional texts

Note: The focus of this assessment is on reading texts in which the order of steps in a sequence (or of events) is important. Some sample ideas for texts and discussion questions are provided, but other similar texts relevant to the individual learner could be used instead. If appropriate, the learner can be supported to check that they understand the instructions for each activity. If they need help with reading particular words, help can be given (and the words noted). In activity 1 the sentences can be cut up and moved about by the learner to help them decide the best order.

## Activity 1
