Sport – visiting a sports centre Integrated numeracy and literacy activity

Speaking and listening:

Whole group discussion on sport. Learners brainstorm ideas of sports they would like to try.

Introduce topic of visiting a sports centre. Learners discuss what they need to find out about a sports centre before visiting.

Curriculum references

Writing and Data Handling:

Working in pairs, learners make a list of information that they need. Feedback to whole group and compare content of lists. Check that they have included: directions, prices and timerelated information. Pairs of learners then draw up a table to record this information.



ICT:

Ask learners to work in a pair, one with familiarity in using an internet browser with one who is a beginner. Experienced learner talks the novice through the steps of using a browser to find the Home Page of the sports centre they are interested in.

Measures and Number (Money):

Learners calculate how much it would cost to visit the sports centre and try their chosen sport. **Curriculum references**

Writing:

Plan and write a letter or email to the centre secretary asking to arrange a visit. **Curriculum references**

Direction and time:

Learners plan their journey to the sports centre – how to get there/what time to go / how long they need at the centre. **Curriculum references**
